SWEET HOME HIGH SCHOOL PARKING PERMIT

All students parking on school grounds must register their vehicle and pay the required \$25.00 fee.

PARKING REGULATIONS

Vehicles parked on District property are under the jurisdiction of the District. Parking on District property is a privilege and not a right. District officials may conduct searches of vehicles upon reasonable suspicion of a violation of policy, rule and/or procedure.

PARKING AREA: Students may park in the parking lots designated for students (across from High School, west end of the school, gravel area behind the school, and in front of the cafeteria). Reserved parking spots will be available for SENIORS ONLY! (first come, first served basis) All other campus parking is off limits.

REGULATIONS:

- 1. The student must have a valid Oregon State driver's license.
- 2. Students are to obey all traffic laws and drive in a safe manner on and around the high school campus.
- 3. Students are to park in the designated student parking lots (valid during school hours -7:00AM-4:00PM).
- 4. Once students arrive at school they are expected to stay out of their vehicles. The one exception is the lunch period. Students wanting access to their vehicles during the school day must get permission from the office before going to their vehicle.

Violations of parking policies may result in loss of privilege to park in student parking lots, loss of ability to bring vehicles onto school property, or other disciplinary actions. Vehicles in violation of SHHS Parking Policies and Regulations may be ticketed or towed at the owner's expense.

PARKING FEES: The \$25.00 parking fee covers permit stickers or hang-tags, increased security, and parking lot striping. Place sticker on rear driver's side window or place hang-tags on the mirror.
