Erin's Law

Many states, including Oregon, have passed laws in the past several years with the intent of increasing the awareness of child abuse, including child sexual abuse. One of the requirements of this law is that schools provide an age-appropriate curriculum to all students relating to personal body safety and how to speak up and tell if they are being abused. During the 2025-26 school year, the school counselor will be presenting lessons to class to meet the requirements of Erin's Law.
